YOUR GENEROSITY IN ACTION

Roslyn "Sunny" Gomes of Glendale, Ariz. was one of the first patients in the nation – and the first in Arizona – to undergo a non-surgical, catheter-based procedure with a new type of stroke-prevention stent that eliminates blockages in neck arteries that could potentially cause a deadly stroke by depriving the brain of oxygen.

Sunny, 76, has suffered from peripheral artery disease for years. She already has three stents in her heart and so many stents and replacement arteries in both her legs that she's lost count.

A previous scan some years ago revealed a partial blockage of her right carotid artery, but a recent set of scans showed it was 85 percent blocked, making her a good candidate for the new clinical trial.

The Neuroguard Integrated Embolic Protection (IEP) system is an experimental treatment for carotid artery stenosis, also known as carotid artery disease. This is a condition in which fatty-waxy deposits build up and block the normal flow of blood in the large arteries on either side of the neck. Left untreated, this condition can lead to stroke with severe complications, including death.

"I feel a lot better today than I have," said Sunny, days after her procedure. "I really love all of my doctors. They've been really good to me. They've saved my right leg twice now."
